The 2004 offering of LaMancha is a blend from the entire estate vineyard. The retrellising of the vineyard gave us very low yields in 2004. Plus, with the heat of last August all of the varieties were ready at the same time. Rather than make a tiny amount of each variety, I decided to make a true vineyard blend.

The Cabernet Sauvignon and the Syrah were co fermented, as were the Petite Sirah and Nebbiolo. Early pressing (4.0 Brix) helped keep the vibrant fruit aromas. The wine was then aged in 34% new French oak and 66% 3 year old barrels.

The youthfulness of this wine shows in the explosion of berries and bright fruit in the aroma. Full flavored yet moderate of tannin the wine finishes long with a juicy finish.

This wine longs for summer evenings and barbecues. A perfect match to ribs or steaks the wine is soft enough to be enjoyed with salmon and other rich fish.
