This is the release of our third "Reserve" wine. This is a designation that we save only for our finest wines from the best vintages. 2007 was an exceptional vintage in the Sierra Foothills. Sitting on the edge of the South Fork of the American River brought us the cool nights that we needed for slow ripening throughout the extended growing period. Over two years of ageing in new French Oak from the Vose region developed the complex aromas and interaction of oak and fruit.

Explosive aromas of blackberry, cassis and cedar provide an enticement to the ripe plum flavors. Rich and full bodied the wine shows supple tannin structure and finishes with lingering impressions of berries and sweet oak. Tasting great right now this wine will add to any fare and give enjoyment for another five to ten years.

For our friends who supported our "Beast Cancer Fund Raiser" this is the final result of two years of following its progress in the cellar barrel tasting!
